這類會員都是較為年青的一代，而他們都在不同的崗位為香港以及境外，例如大灣區的城市發展作出貢獻，希望政府的德政可以也涵蓋這些年青人。

再者，也有很多內地以及一帶一路國家的學生在香港攻讀城市設計課程，若果可以吸引這些學生學成之後留港工作，可以幫助香港解決人才短缺的問題。

Thank you for your response, and Development Bureau's efforts in assisting professionals in Hong Kong in capturing the opportunities in the mainland in past years.

The Hong Kong Institute of Urban Design is a multi-disciplinary institute, with many of our members holding qualifications in the five professions mentioned in your reply. However, there are also a significant number of members who, apart from being professional members of the Hong Kong Institute of Urban Design, do not possess other professional qualifications.

Currently, the University of Hong Kong, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, and the City University of Hong Kong offer urban design programmes accredited by our institute. Graduates from these programmes, after gaining adequate professional experience, will apply to become our members directly. At present, a significant number of our members do not hold other professional qualifications, and the number of such members is increasing steadily.

In general, these members belong to the younger generation, and are contributing to urban development in Hong Kong and beyond, such as in the Greater Bay Area. We hope that the Government's good policies can also encompass these young individuals.

Moreover, there are many students from the mainland and the Belt and Road countries studying urban design in Hong Kong. If we can attract these students to stay and work in Hong Kong after graduation, it could help alleviate the talent shortage in the city.

The Hong Kong Institute of Urban Design will approach Development Bureau to discuss this issue in more detail. We will provide more information at our meeting.
